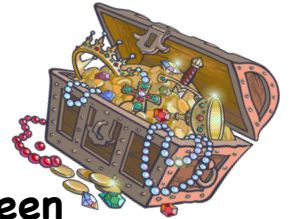

RULES

1. Between 10 and 11 a.m., meet in the Rose Room in the basement of City Hall, 1225 Lincoln Way. Pick up your grab bag with water, snacks and your clues. You have two choices: work together or scoot off individually.
2. Any business open between 10 a.m. and 3 p.m. might have an answer to one of those clues... but it might not. Be sure before you investigate. The answer to the clue you're working on might not even be in a business. Might be... say... at an intersection. A museum. Part of a sidewalk. If you don't find an answer to the clue in a business, then you'll need to pick up the answer some other way – like making a rubbing. AAUW encourages you to use your imagination – and sense of fun – when participating in this event. Yes, we ask you to compete, but this is a Scavenger Hunt. Have a good time!
3. Teams consist of three members, who are encouraged to collaborate on the answer to each clue.
4. The Team Captain is the designated speaker/writer for the team, and will hand over the answers to the clues.
5. Clues and answers are selected by the AAUW Auburn Adventure committee.
6. Team members can work together or separately, but only one clue answer per question per team counts. There are no penalties for incorrect answers.
7. You'll need to show physical evidence that you approached.
8. Teams may not receive help from those not part of the team.
9. Competition consists of clues. A "Sudden Death" round will be played, if necessary.
10. All points are public.
11. Each correct item per team earns a point. There are no penalties for incorrect answers.
12. The judges will make the final decisions on all items.
13. Encourage your friends to cheer you on at Old Town Pizza, at Gold Country Fairgrounds.
14. Keep your eyes open for extra point opportunities! If you happen to find something with an
