- 1. has maintained a 3.0 GPA or higher,
- 2. is applying to a 4-year college or university (preferred majors of science, technology, health sciences, engineering or mathematics)
- 3. will submit <u>two letters of recommendation</u>, <u>a high school transcript</u>, <u>a</u> <u>resume</u> and <u>the application</u> by March 1, 2025.
- 4. Please combine all of #3 into one complete pdf file and email to Diane Fishburn. <u>dianefriverpark@aol.com</u> Diane will confirm receipt.
 - ⇒ If you have not worked with scanning documents or creating pdf documents, please get help from a parent or from someone in the counseling office, well in advance of the deadline. Google Docs will not be accepted.
 - \Rightarrow Late or incomplete applications will not be accepted.
 - ⇒ Please work on the logistics of creating a pdf before the application deadline.
- 5. Finalists may be required to interview with the selection committee before final decisions are made.
