RULES

1. AAUW encourages you to use your imagination and sense of fun when preparing for this event. Yes, we ask you to compete, but this is a TRIVIA Bee. We're here to have a good time. Our SPORTS theme is just the beginning of having fun.

1A: If you like, dress up. This can be as simple or as elaborate as you choose. Get as fancy as you want. But only if you want. Not everyone dresses up.

2. Teams consist of three members, who are encouraged to collaborate on each answer.

3. The Team Captain is the designated speaker/writer for the team.

4. Trivia questions and answers are selected by the AAUW Trivia Bee committee.

5. All questions will be announced by the Beekeeper of Ceremonies. Each question will be asked twice, and a 20-second time limit will start after the reading. After each question is asked, each team's written response will be reviewed by AAUW scorekeepers. No writing will be allowed after the time has expired.

6. Teams may not receive help from the audience.

7. Competition consists of two rounds of 15 questions. A "Sudden Death" round will be played, if necessary.

8. All points are public. All teams continue competing after the first round.

9. Each correct answer earns a point. There are no penalties for incorrect answers. But see rule #11.

10. The judge will make the final decisions on all answers.

11. Before the last question asked for both rounds, each team has the opportunity to bet all, some, or none of their points. The Team Captain inserts the bet in the folder's inner sleeve. If the team's answer is correct, the proctors add the betting number to the score. If the answer is incorrect, the proctors will subtract that number.

Scoring in the second round will continue as before, adding one point for each correct answer, until before the 30th question. Teams may bet again. As always, the team with the most points wins.

12. ALL teams MUST leave ALL electronics at home or with friends in the audience or be disqualified.
