With their help, our branch doubled the number of Auburn area schools participating STEM teachers who sent us camper nominations compared to the last 3 years. We then doubled the number of camper applicant interviews we held. The results are that the **Auburn branch will provide 14 Tech Trek Camperships to 14 girls to attend camp this July**—double the number of campers from last year!
